



# EXPO LINE: Light Rail from Downtown Los Angeles to Santa Monica

**Samantha Bricker**, Chief Operating Officer for the Exposition Metro Line Construction Authority, will discuss plans for construction of the Expo Line from downtown Los Angeles to Santa Monica. Samantha will share with us the successes and challenges of creating a transit parkway through urban neighborhoods, with an emphasis on real estate issues. She will discuss the agreement with the city of Culver City which contemplates development at the Culver City station, and the potential for mixed use and transit oriented development at other sites along the Phase 2 Project to Santa Monica.



**Samantha Bricker** has been Chief Operating Officer for the Exposition Construction Authority since 2006. She oversees community and government relations, real estate, legal, procurement, labor and compliance, human resources and financial matters.

Before joining the Authority, she worked for almost 15 years as a policy advisor to Los Angeles County Supervisor Zev Yaroslavsky, who is a member of the Exposition Construction Authority and LA Metropolitan Transportation Authority Board of Directors. During her tenure, she worked on major transportation projects such as the Red Line subway to Hollywood and North Hollywood, the Orange Line busway in the San Fernando Valley as well as the Expo Line.
