Dr. Green also taught real estate finance and economics courses at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. He also has been principal economist and director of financial strategy and policy analysis at Freddie Mac. He was a visiting professor at the University of Pennsylvania's Wharton School. His research addresses housing markets, housing policy, tax policy, transportation, mortgage finance and urban growth.

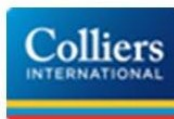
